

RESOLUTION: 19-01

ADOPTED: February 25, 2019

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE, BY INTERNET AUCTION DURING CALENDAR YEAR 2019, OF MUNICIPALLY OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY WHICH IS NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE OR WHICH IS OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR THE USE FOR WHICH IT WAS ACQUIRED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.C. 721.15(D), Council for the Village of Thornville is required to adopt, during each calendar year, a resolution expressing its intent to sell municipally owned property, regardless of the property's value, by internet auction. This resolution must include a description of how auctions will be conducted, specifying the number of days for bidding, and stating the general terms and conditions of sale; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thornville wants to use GovDeals, Inc. at GovDeals.com, as the Village's contracted representative to conduct auctions on its behalf.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: During calendar year 2019, municipally owned personal property which is not needed for public use, or which is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired, may be sold at internet auction.

SECTION 2: All internet auction sales shall be conducted under the authority and direction of the Village Administrator or her designee(s).

SECTION 3: All internet auction sales shall be conducted by GovDeals.com internet auction service, 5907 Carmichael Place, Montgomery, AL 36117, phone (800) 613-0156.

SECTION 4: All internet auction sales shall be conducted pursuant to the rules and regulations promulgated and in effect for GovDeals.com.

SECTION 5: For each internet auction sale, bidding shall remain open for not less than ten (10) days, including Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays.

SECTION 6: The Village of Thornville shall publish, in a newspaper of general circulation within the Village, or as provided in R.C. 7.16, notice of its intent to sell unneeded, obsolete, or unfit municipal personal property by internet auction. This notice shall include a summary of the information provided herein and shall be published twice. The second notice shall be published not less than ten (10) nor more than twenty (20) days after the previous notice. A similar notice also shall be posted continually throughout the calendar year in a conspicuous place in the office of the Village Clerk. The notice also shall be posted continually throughout the calendar year on the Village's web site.

SECTION 7: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

SECTION 8: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Village of Thornville which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 9: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that the Village needs to adopt this Resolution immediately, so it can begin selling personal property via internet auction in calendar year 2019. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the required affirmative votes of

Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.
