

RESOLUTION NO. 22-10  
ADOPTED: 12-19-2023

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO REQUEST PERMISSIVE TAX FUNDS FROM THE PERRY COUNTY ENGINEER TO PAY FOR THE PAVING OF LONGVIEW DRIVE, BRADLEY STREET, GRANDVIEW DRIVE, AND N. MAIN STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Longview Drive, Bradley Street, Grandview Drive, and N. Main Street were paved in October (October 2022 Paving Project). However, the Village is now receiving the invoices for this work; and

WHEREAS, to pay for this paving project, the Village needs to request permissive tax funds from the Perry County Engineer.

NOW, **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Thornville, County of Perry, State of Ohio:

- SECTION 1: The Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to request Permissive Tax Funds from the Perry County Engineer in the amount of \$29,541.09 to be used to pay for the October 2022 Paving Project. As part of this authorization, the Village Administrator may execute and file an application, and all other documents necessary, to secure this funding on behalf of the Village of Thornville.
- SECTION 2: All prior legislation, or parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.
- SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of Council and any decision-making bodies of the Village of Thornville, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.
- SECTION 4: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality, and the further reason that the Village need to make this application and receive this money as soon as possible to pay these outstanding invoices. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.


